COOKIES POLICY

1. SCOPE OF THIS POLICY

Coverys International Insurance Company DAC ("**Coverys**", "we", "our" and "us") respects the privacy of all visitors on our website <u>www.coverysinternational.com</u> ("**Website**").

This is our policy on the use of cookies and other technologies on the Website. We may update this policy from time to time to reflect any changes in technology or legislation affecting the way we use cookies. Any updates to this policy will be posted to this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure you are happy with our use of the cookies and to update your cookie preferences, where you have consented to our use of cookies.

2. SUMMARY OF THIS POLICY

When you first visit our Website, we only set strictly necessary cookies on your Device (as defined in section 3 below). We will only deploy non-necessary cookies on your Device when we have obtained your prior consent to do so (see section 5 of this policy for further details).

If you choose to consent to our use of **non-necessary cookies**, you may withdraw your consent to these cookies at any time (see section 8 of this policy for further details). You should also know that some of our cookies collect and process your personal data. We have set out more information about these cookies in sections 5, 6 and 7 of this policy and you can find further details about our processing of your personal data in our Website Privacy Notice.

3. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are stored in your web browser on your PC, telephone, tablet or other Internet-connected device (each a "**Device**") that "remember" information about you and your visit(s) to a website or connection to a web application. Certain cookies collect and process personal data about you from your Device. This personal data can include your name, IP address, time and date of access and e-mail address. See our <u>Website Privacy Notice</u> for more information about how we process your personal data.

Cookies can be "first party" which are cookies set by us, or "third-party" which are cookies placed on your Device by a third party when you visit our Website. Third-party cookies may be placed on your Device by a third party providing a service to us. For example, we use [Google Analytics] to help us understand how our Website is being used.

4. WHY DO WE USE COOKIES?

Our Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us to provide you with a better experience when you visit our Website. It also assists us to make improvements to our Website.

Cookies enable the Website to remember your interactions and preferences over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them when you come back to the Website or browse from one page to another. For example, non-personal data relating to your Device such as language settings, font size settings, other display preferences or other information relating to your Device. Cookies also help our Website to work faster and route information over your network.

5. TYPES OF COOKIES ON OUR WEBSITE

This section of our policy explains the different types of cookies used on our Website and which cookies do / do not require your consent:

- Strictly necessary Cookies: we use so-called "technical" cookies and other similar cookies to carry out activities that are strictly necessary for the operation or delivery of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that register the type and version of your browser. For this reason, we do not require your prior consent to place these cookies on your Device. If you disable these cookies, then the Website will not function properly.
- Functionality Cookies: These cookies are non-necessary and are used to recognise you when you return to our Website. By cookies recognising you, it enables us to personalise our content for you, including, where applicable, to remember choices you make (such as your language or the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features. We are required to obtain your prior consent to use these cookies on your Device.
- Analytical/Performance Cookies: These cookies are non-necessary and allow us to recognise visitors to our Website. These cookies also count the number of visitors to our Website and help us to understand how visitors use our Website. This information helps us to improve the way our Website works. For example, by ensuring that users find what they are looking for easily. This information is gathered anonymously it is not to enable us to identify visitors to our Website. We use these cookies to determine the kind of content and services our visitors value the most. This, in turn, helps us improve our Website, its content and our business strategy.

6. INFORMATION ABOUT OUR FIRST-PARTY COOKIES

The table below provides more information about the first-party cookies that we use on the Website, why we use them and the period for which the Website will retain information collected by each cookie:

• by clicking "accept all", you consent to all strictly necessary and non-necessary cookies before they are deployed on your Device; and

• by clicking "decline all", you consent to all strictly necessary cookies only.

9. DISABLING AND DELETING COOKIES

You may also set your browser to disable cookies, but this action may block our strictly necessary cookies and prevent our Website from functioning properly, and you may not be able to fully utilise all of the Website's features and services.
